Agricultural Drought Workshop organized by General Directorate of Agricultural Reform was held in our Center between 25-26 April 2019. Approximately 45 experts on agricultural drought from institutes affiliate of Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry and Ege University participated in workshop.

It was agreed that the agriculture sector is one of the most negatively affected sector in terms of climate change and that the agricultural sector is foremost applications to be implemented in order to increase the capacity of adaptation to climate change.



In this context, it was decided to carry out agricultural activities by taking into consideration the principles of sustainable water-soil and land management. In addition, the workshop was completed by discussing what type of studies can be done to cope against agricultural drought and forward-looking strategies.

During the training, lecturers from Ankara University and Çankırı Karatekin University and experts from TAGEM lectured on the subjects of;; food safety in the dairy industry, food contaminants, management systems used to ensure food safety, additives used in meat and meat products and their intended use, ethics in agriculture and food production and marketing, new food product development and innovation in marketing, food safety and smart practices.

Within the scope of the training, technical trips to Pınar Meat and Milk Factories and Fig Research Institute were

organized. A presentation was made by the general manager and employees at Pinar Meat and Dairy Factories about the history, duties and responsibilities of the factory and the participants were informed about the tools standards, equipment used in meat and milk production and the methods they applied.

During the training, experts and faculty members from Ankara University, Dicle University, Akdeniz University, Egirdir Fruit Research Institute, TAGEM and our Center gave lectures on agricultural irrigation, irrigation systems, water quality,

and drainage and computer applications in irrigation.

Within the scope of the training, participants visited Seferihisar Ürkmez Irrigation Facilities of State Hydraulic Works. Officers of the facility gave information on irrigation, automation and fish farming to participants.















Turkvet and Veterinary Information System Evaluation Meeting

"TURKVET and Veterinary Information System Evaluation Meeting" organized by General Directorate of Food and Control, Department of Animal Health and Quarantine was held in our Center with the participation of 70 veterinarians working in the Provincial Directorates of

Aydın, Denizli, İzmir, Manisa, Muğla, Kütahya and Uşak between 18-20 June 2019.

During the meeting, with the Animal Registration System (TÜRKVET), with the experience gained from the previous systems, solutions have been produced for problems experienced in the past, the

infrastructure has been made stronger, and the Veterinary Information System, which has been made available to the field, has entered into a new process in the follow-up of vaccination and disease records, also epidemiological follow-up of the disease.

Training on Soil Analysis

"Soil Analysis" training was held in our Center with 2 participants from Azerbaijan between 03 - 31 July 2019.

During the training, theoretical and practical courses were given to participants on all processes of Soil, Plant, Water and Fertilizer Laboratory star-

ting from sample reception, preparation of test samples, soil, plant and irrigation water analysis, operation of the instruments, preparation of soil test report, to interpretation of results. Moreover, lectures were given about fertilization and recommen-

dation of fertilizer by Department of Soil and Plant Nutrition

COMCEC - Reducing Food Loss and Waste in OIC

A training course within the scope of "Reducing Food Loss and Waste in OIC" Project, coded 2019-TURAGRIC-559 which was proposed by Directorate General for European Union and Foreign Relations on behalf of Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry and entitled for support in the 6th Call Period of Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (COMCEC), was held between 22 – 26 July 2019 in our Center.

25 participant attended the training from Indonesia, Morocco, Palestine, Qatar and Tunisia, including the representatives from Presidential Strategy and Budget Office and Development and Investment Bank of Turkey.

The training, which was contributed by the representatives of United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) Sub regional Office for Central Asia and Organization of Basic Necessities (TİDER), was launched with the opening speeches of Dilek KAHRA-MAN, Director of International Agricultural Research and Training Center, Ali ORUÇ, Strategy and Budget Assistant Expert from COMCEC Coordination Office, Musa BAKAN, Director of İzmir Agriculture and Forestry Provincial Directorate and A. Volkan GÜNGÖREN. Deputy Director General of Directorate General for European Union and Foreign Relations. Prof. Hami ALPAS from Food Engineering Department of Middle East Technical University implemented the training and the workshop.



The training, funded by COMCEC, aimed to increase capacity of key actors of 6 countries, including ours, in terms of measures taken against food loss and waste. The workshop was successfully concluded by evaluating current status of opportunities and obstacles in reducing food loss and waste in participating countries, legal infrastructure, good practice examples, standards, date collection and analyses systems also discussing possible cooperation points.
