Summary	:	The species composition of the pathogenic fungi in <i>Laurus</i> <i>nobilis</i> and the sources for infection had been investigated for the first time at four sites in the Western Anatolia region of Turkey. Isolation was carried out from the leaves, current-year twigs and brances. Some species were isolated at all four sites but with variable frequency; the most consistent members of this group were <i>Phomopsis sp.</i> B, <i>Botryosphaeria sarmentorum</i> , <i>Phomopsis sp.</i> C and <i>Phoma sp.</i> Other less frequently recovered species were <i>Seimatosporium lichenicola</i> , <i>Colletotrichum</i> <i>gloeosporioides</i> , <i>Hendersonula sp.</i> , <i>Phomopsis sp.</i> A, <i>Paraconiothyrium sp.</i> and <i>Colletotrichum dematium</i> . The isolation frequencies of the dominant species, as well as other less frequent species, were significantly dependent on the sampling site. The degree of pathogenic infection and the diversity of fungal species were significantly higher in the spring.
