### 3<sup>rd</sup> Workshop on the Effects of Climate Change on Agriculture

"3<sup>rd</sup> Workshop on Effects of Climate Change on Agriculture" organized by General Directorate of Agricultural Research and Policies within the framework of Climate Change and Agricultural Ecology Studies was held in our Center between 5-7 November 2018.

The opening ceremony was carried out by TAGEM Director General Mr. Özkan KAYACAN. Director General Mr. Özkan KAYACAN highlighted that Turkey is among the countries which is open to the effects of climate change on agriculture and food production due to Turkey's location in the Mediterranean basin where is the most affected by climate change, and the importance of the agricultural sector in the country economically and socially. Research institutes affiliated to our General Directorate emphasized the importance of integrating R & D activities into the agricultural sector and food security policies in order to adapt to the effects of climate change, intended for





sustainable use of agricultural soils and water resources, drought, development of drought resistant varieties, deficit irrigation programs, conservation of genetic resources, use of renewable energy sources, Industry 4.0, Intelligent agriculture and technologies at regional, national and international scale to improve the recommendations and policies to measure the impact of climate change on agricultural systems and to take measures. In the workshop, Deputy Director General of Agricultural Reform, Dr. Metin TÜRKER expressed applications of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry in his presentation on "Effects of Climate Change to Agriculture".

65 specialists from Plant Protection Products Department, Plant Health Researches Department of General Directorate of Agricultural Research, Plant Production and Plant Health Branches of Aegean and Marmara Region provinces, Bornova Plant Protection Research Institute, Yalova Atatürk Horticultu-

ral Center Research Institute, Edirne Trakya Agricultural Research Institute and Izmir Directorate of Agricultural Quarantine participated to the meeting which is organized by Department of Plant Health and Quarantine, General Directorate of Food and Control.

### **Nitrates Directive Good Agricultural Practices Code Training**

In-service training on "Nitrates Directive Good Agricultural Practices Code" organized by General Directorate of Agricultural Reform, Department of Protection of Agricultural Environment and Natural Resources was held in our Center between 5-7 December 2018. The training was carried out with the participation of 165 technical personnel working in the Provincial Directorates about nitrate pollution caused by agricultural activities.

Head of Department of Protection of Agricultural Environment and Natural Resources Dr. Ali Kılıç ÖZBEK pointed out the importance of the works to be carried out by Provincial Directorates to prevent pollution caused by agricultural activities and gave information about the activities of the Ministry.

Trainers from General Directorate of Agricultural Reform, General Directorate of Water Management, Soil Fertilizer

and Water Resources Central Research Institute, Ege University Faculty of Agriculture, Nature Conservation Center made presentations in the training meeting on; nitrate pollution caused by agricultural activities, pollution in accordance with the results obtained in nitrate pollution monitoring studies, land management for prevention of nitrate pollution from agricultural origin, plant nutrient management, animal manure management, irrigation management, determination of nitrate sensitive zones, river basin management plans, nature conservation activities, climate change adaptation studies and Good Agricultural Practices Code.

Speaking at the closing of the training program Deputy Director General Dr. Metin Türker; drew attention that as a result of the agricultural activities that are not sensitive to the environment, the intensive use of inputs and the impact of



agriculture on soil and water resources have accelerated the destruction of attention. Pointing out that fertilizer is the most important input to increase the productivity in agricultural production, Türker stated that nitrate pollution is increasing day by day with the use of fertilizers and unconsciousness.

The training meeting was completed with the evaluation of the problems encountered during the studies related to the monitoring and prevention works of agricultural nitrate pollution at the Provincial Directorates.
