## 6<sup>th</sup> CONGRESS ON SOIL AND WATER RESOURCES WITH INTERNATIONAL PARTICIPATION

6<sup>th</sup> Congress on Soil and Water Resources with International Participation held with the support and contributions of Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry of Republic of Turkey, along with the participation of universities and institutions working on related topics in our country, between 12-14 November 2019 in UTAEM, Menemen, İzmir. Following the speeches of Dilek KAHRA-MAN, Director of UTAEM and Congress Chairman, Prof. Yusuf Ersoy YILDIRIM, Dean of Faculty of Agriculture in Eskişehir Osmangazi University, Dr. Bülent SÖNMEZ, Head of Department of Soil and Water Resources of GDAR and Mustafa ÖZKAYNAK, Menemen District Governor in the opening session of the Congress, invited papers were presented.

Within the scope of the Congress, Dr. Anna OSANN presented "The Changing World of Agriculture"; Prof.





Ayten **NAMLI** presented "Agronomic and Environmental Features of Biochar"; Prof. GEZGİN Sait presented "Fertility of Soil in Turkey" and Prof. Haruyuki Fujimaki presented "Determination of Irrigation Depths using WASH 2D and Weather Forecast".

**GÜBRETAŞ** Fertilizer Company, UPL Agriculture and Chemicals Industry and Trade Limited Company, Turkish Coal Enterprises Institution, METOS TR, Paksoy Technical Services Trade Limited Company and Pressurized Irriga-Industry Association tion sponsored the Congress, which was supported by Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey (TUBITAK) within the scope of 2223-B Domestic Scientific Event Planning Support Program, these institutions also presented in the opening session. The Congress was held

with 264 participants in total; 22 participants from Bulgaria, Croatia, Czechia, Greece, Iran, Japan, Serbia, Spain and Ukraine, 52 faculty members from universities, 105 researchers from research institutes and 87 researchers from different institutions, for three days, in 26 sessions, simultaneously taking place in 4 different halls.

In the Congress, 139 oral and 33 poster presentations took place; under the Soil and Plant Nutrition topic 54 oral and 15 poster presentations, under the Agricultural Irrigation topic 41 oral and 8 poster presentations, under the Climate Change and Agricultural Ecology topic 23 oral and 8 poster presentations, under the Agricultural Mechanization and Information Technologies 15 oral and 1 poster presentations and under the Natural Resource Economy topic 4 oral and 1 poster presentations.

During the course, experts from Bornova Plant Protection Research Institute instructed lectures about integrated pest management and methods for reduction of pesticide use.

Within the scope of the training, technical visits were organized on 16 - 17 October 2019 to an orchard in Selcuk district and Bornova Plant Protection Research Institute, respectively. During the technical visits, experts showed examples of alternative practices, integrated pest control and shared their knowledge and experience about the pesticide techniques.

"2019 Regional Group Meeting", coordinated by Aegean Agricultural Research Institute, was held in UTAEM between 26 - 28 November 2019.

135 participants from departments of coordination,

plant production and health, animal health and breeding, fisheries and aquaculture of İzmir, Manisa, Aydın, Denizli, Çanakkale, Balıkesir and Denizli Provincial Directorates, research institutes, universities attended to the

meeting. During the meeting, lectures were instructed on the issues of regional problems and extension projects carried out by the provincial directorates with research institutes were explained.

### **Agricultural Credit Cooperatives Orientation Training**

## ""Breath for Future" Sapling Planting Campaign

Within the scope of the "Breath for Future" Campaign of Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry for a 'A greener Turkey, a more livable World", 11 million saplings were simultaneously planted at 11:11 on 11.11.2019 at 81 cities. UTAEM did its part by planting olive saplings in Menemen and also in Köyceğiz Soil and Water Conservation, Trial and Demonstration Station, for 'Breath for Future'.

According to the Presidential Decree, every year 11th of November is celebrated as "National Forestation Day". Citizens took great interest in the first rally of 'A Breath for Future' coordinated by the





Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, the campaign also aims to break two records as well. The campaign wants to register Turkey in Guinness World Records in "Planting the most seedlings within 1 hour" by planting 301111 seedlings in Çorum. Currently, the record belongs to Indonesia with 232647 seedlings.

The second record is to create "the largest online photo album of people planting seedlings" which will be formed with photos of the citizens planting seedlings in 81 cities.
